

Pastor's Pen



"Jesus came and stood among [the disciples] and said, 'Peace be with you.' After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord." (John 20:19b-20) We hear this proclamation every year as part of the gospel reading assigned to the second Sunday of Easter. The disciples recognize Jesus by his crucifixion wounds. Jesus has been raised from the dead; but our risen Lord still carries the marks of his past with him.

As individuals and as members of a church community, we, the body of Christ, also carry the marks of our past with us. These wounds and scars may help identify us, but they don't define us. The 1984 Barneveld tornado is one of BLC's scars, but the congregation is so much more than this one experience. More important than the scars, is the living body which bears these marks. The scars are a reminder of death, but they rest on One who has been raised from the dead! To the people of Corinth, Paul wrote: "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed: always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be made visible in our bodies." (2 Cor. 4:8-10)

Many scars mark our society and the church: COVID, political division, war, displaced people, sin, disease, and death; but God gifts us life in the midst of all this! "Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.' When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit." (John 20:21-

22) The same Holy Spirit that accompanied us at our baptisms continues to accompany us each and every day; empowering us, energizing us, and inspiring us to be the body of Christ in Barneveld and beyond!

Easter is more than a day, it's more than a season! Easter is the lens through which we can see our risen Lord active and present before us even in the midst of the world's suffering and pain. Through Jesus the Christ, God has experienced our humanity: betrayal, abandonment, suffering, and death. But through Jesus, we can hope in the promise of new life out of this death! Equipped with God's life-giving Spirit we are called to go out into the world proclaiming the Good News of God's love and life for all! It is this Spirit which has sustained Christians for over two millennia, and BLC for over a century! May God's Spirit, breathed upon you by our Risen Lord, continue to inspire you as you follow God's call to be the body of Christ in Barneveld and beyond!

Alleluia! Christ is risen!

Recipe of the Month from Ronda Bowe

Spinach and Strawberry Salad

1 (10-12 ounce) package baby spinach, washed and dried 1/3 cup sliced almonds, toasted

1 pint strawberries, hulled and quartered

1 medium cucumber - peeled, seeded and finely diced

Dressing

1/2 lemon, juiced

2 TBSP white wine vinegar

1/3 cup sugar

1 TBSP vegetable oil

1 tsp poppyseeds



Directions:

In a large salad bowl add: spinach, almonds (toasted), strawberries, and cucumbers.

Make the dressing in a small glass bowl or jar with a tight fitting lid: combine the lemon juice, vinegar, sugar, oil, and poppyseeds. Whisk together in the glass bowl or shake if you was in a jar.

*Add the dressing right before serving.
