# **Avoid Tick Bites**

Tuck shirt into pants and pants into socks to cover gaps in your clothing where ticks can get in. Wear light -colored clothing to be able to see ticks more easily. Check the entire body for ticks; promptly remove attached ticks without squeezing them.

\* Insect repellent is effective. Try permethrin-based clothing or mosquito repellent with at least 30% deet; works best when spraying the bottom of your pants and your shoes.

# Recipe of the Month from Ronda Bowe

# Broccoli Salad

- I pkg. Broccoli slaw
- I cup Slivered almonds
- I cup Sunflower seeds
- 2 pkgs. of Beef Ramen Noodles broken into small clumps (reserve seasoning packet)

# In a separate bowl, whisk together:

3/4 cup oil1/2 cup sugar1/3 cup apple cider vinegar2 packets of seasoning from the Beef Ramen Noodles



Drizzle over broccoli slaw mixture and toss well. Chill in the refrigerator for one hour before serving to allow flavors to meld and noodles to soften. I prefer this salad best when served the same day that it is made as the noodles are still somewhat crunchy, but it does taste good the next day with softer noodles too.
