Summer is flying by!

As we move closer to fall, there are some key themes I encourage you to think about and most importantly, **pray** about. You may not have realized it, but we have already been working on these questions through the last couple of months.

1) **Identity.** Who are we? How does my identity in Christ shape my daily life?

The story of Mary and Martha, paints a picture of what identity in Christ means. Jesus reminds us how important it is that we spend time with him. That we spend time in strengthening our relationship with him through prayer, worship and service. I challenge you to find ways to include Jesus into your daily life. I know you are busy—I am busy too and I, too, realize how difficult this is. However, deep connection with Jesus helps us not lose hope, helps us navigate through dark times, and helps us find gratitude in our everyday lives.

2) Purpose. What has God called us (BLC) to do? How has God called us to be servants of the Gospel?

Yesterday, we celebrated my installation as your new Pastor at BLC. I am honored and grateful! The words of Jesus' parable of the rich fool are still knocking around in my head. Thoughts of purpose. "I have arrived!" is what the rich fool thought. Having the best return on his crop ever, his barns were full and so were his pockets. He felt he was set! He was done. But rather than an ending, we learn that this is a beginning.

I know it has been a bit of a confusing and rocky couple of years here. I know you still have grief and even some hurt feelings. Installing your new pastor doesn't make that go away. But what it does do, is strengthen the team. Together we are the team! A team that must honor and heal the past, dream of the future and give of our hearts and hands to bring life to new ministry. I urge you to think about joining a ministry team, volunteering to teach Sunday School or Confirmation, participate in an Adult Study this fall—find ways to engage. Come see me if you aren't sure how to plug in. Come & See how the Spirit is kindling new fire!

After all, faith is not a spectator sport.

3) **Context.** Who is our neighbor?

Finally, thoughts of the Good Samaritan linger with echoes of who is our neighbor and how do we show mercy. We will begin a new sermon series in August called, "New Places for New People." Through scripture, we will connect our lives to Jesus' command, "Go out and make disciples of the world!" We will think about insiders & outsiders, facing our fears and how we are God's equipment in this world.

This is only the beginning and there is much work to do!

For the month of August, as we move into Fall, I encourage you to use this simple prayer:

Dear Lord, Use me today. Multiply your kingdom through me. Amen.

AVOID POISON PARSNIPS

If you come in contact with wild parsnip sap followed by exposure to sunlight, it will cause a burn and blisters, you can try ice packs for pain relief. If needed, try an over-the-counter hydrocortisone cream to help soothe the inflammation. You might also consider using ibuprofen or acetaminophen for pain relief.
